1.0 Client

Central Coast Municipal Council

2.0 Project Purpose

Upgrade existing Sports Field Lighting at the Ulverstone Showground, Sports & Leisure Complex

Reason for the project

To improve and extend the lighting area and functionality of the existing training lights.

1. To investigate the feasibility of establishing additional training lights at the Ulverstone Showground Sports & Leisure Complex – Soccer Training area
2. To provide an overall lighting design for the designated sports field areas (to allow for the playing of Soccer and Softball)

3.0 Expected Outcomes

On completion of the project the consultant will be expected to have:

Part 1.

- reviewed existing lighting design
- determined the capacity of the existing lighting infrastructure
- develop a concept design to provide the additional lighting for the nominated training area
- provided an estimate of cost for the implementing the design

Part 2.

- develop a lighting design that encompasses existing lighting infrastructure, including recommendations for Part 1 that will provide sufficient lighting for the playing of sport in the nominated playing areas.

4.0 Guidelines for Consultants

4.1 An estimate of the time required to undertake the project should be submitted and any major changes to this estimate needs to be confirmed with Project Co-ordinator..

4.2 All existing data is available to the consultant together and any other relevant documentation will be provided.

5.0 Project Management

Supervision of the project will be through the Central Coast Council Recreation Facilities Co-ordinator.

6.0 Fee and Payments

6.1 Tenderers are requested to advise an estimate of fees for undertaking the project outlined above.

6.2 The fee for service should include

- time involved
- costs of preparing and submitting documentation
