Proposed Site Plan

The preliminary/concept designs show the layout of two sports ovals and associated facilities aligned to the existing schools and other sports facilities.

Key features include:

- Access road from Recreation Drive and Sports Complex Avenue
- Both ovals are sized to suit regional standard football and cricket
- Synthetic wicket on both ovals
- The pavilion offers **mostly panoramic views** of the site (see other drawings)
- Approximately 234 additional car parking spaces (including 40 spaces beside oval)
- Set down areas in front of pavilion and bus parking bays
- Perimeter pathways for emergency vehicle access and circuit training
- Undercover seating at the pavilion
- Upgrade of existing pathways and additional pathways for easy mobility through the site
- Dedicated area for cricket practice nets and future indoor cricket areas
- Fencing for main oval to allow gated entry
- Central 'community hub' space (see other drawings)
- Scoreboards for both ovals
- Dedicated four (4) bay storage shed for clubs
- Lighting for ovals
- Vegetation and waterways zone
- Additional landscaping areas

Community Hub - Preliminary Concepts

The preliminary/concept designs have been developed to determine what elements people like and what other elements people are looking for.

Key features include:

- An all-weather (synthetic turf) playing and training area
- Central linking pathway (5m wide) for cyclists and pedestrians
- Lawn areas for picnic and casual use with open views to the sports oval
- Unisex toilet facility incorporating one for people with a disability (PWD)
- Zero depth water play areas
- Various style of play areas to suit different interests and abilities
- Provision for various seating arrangements
- Additional landscaping areas
- Some perimeter fencing
- BBQ facilities

Pavilion - Elevations

The preliminary/ concept designs show the exterior of the pavilion and surrounding sloped and tiered areas, and additional seating from various perspectives.

Key features include:

- Three (3) different types of seating including:
 - o Formal grandstand seating under cover individual seats
 - o Semi-formal under cover seating with synthetic surface
 - Very casual under cover (partial) seating on the tiered grass areas- quite wide to allow the spread of picnic blankets
- This mixture of seating is practical and aesthetic as it softens the hard surfaces of the building
- Relevant railings for areas that have an immediate drop are not shown here but would be positioned to meet safety and building standards
- The central grandstand and verandah areas show a roofed covering
- Central and main entrance area is proposed to be glassed
- The glass frontages on the eastern, northern and western perspectives allow for panoramic views of the sports ovals and coastline
- It is intended to have sliding glass doors opening to the outside areas rather than swing doors that could be problematic on the verandah and walkway
- The colour scheme shown is only for presentation and is not final at this stage

Pavilion - Draft Floor Plans

The preliminary/concept floor plans show the ground floor and first floor layouts. More details about the grandstand and external seating areas are in the Fact Sheet for Pavilion - Elevations.

Key features of the ground floor include:

- Central entry point with stairwell and lift access to upper level
- Gallery display space in the central entry area
- Lift access sized to accommodate stretchers
- Four (4) change room areas that can be closed off by bi-fold doors or left open to create one large warm up or bad weather training space
- Dedicated **umpire's change room** with male and female amenities with separate entrance to oval
- Space for a gym
- Two sets of coaches' rooms and trainers' rooms for 'home' and 'away' teams
- Dedicated first aid/medic room
- Four (4) separate storage areas amounting to a total 27m²
- An equipment area (18.31m²) and service area (14.4m²)

Key features of the first floor include:

- Function room space (302.29m²) with glass fronted views to the main oval, secondary oval and the coastline
- Covered verandah areas facing main oval and secondary oval
- Covered **grandstand seating** for 300 people and 4 spaces for people with a disability (PWD)
- Dedicated 'wet' area with views to the oval
- Undercover viewing area
- Centrally positioned bar area to service function room
- Dedicated canteen and kitchen spaces with views to main oval
- Four separate viewing boxes for officials
- Separate meeting room/coaches room
- Four separate areas of **storage space** (25.3m²) and dedicated **cold store** area
- Combination of central entry, and both stairs and ramped entrances to
