Road signs no longer reflective	Council will undertake an audit of road signs during the next 12 months to establish a replacement program. The signs mentioned will be passed on to our Works Operations area for replacement.	PAUL	A sign audit was completed. Some signs have been replaced in the area, with a full replacement program still to be developed. If there are still particular signs of concern please report these directly to Council on 64298100.
Road edges in very bad condition	Comments have been noted and passed to Council's Works Operations area for inclusion in annual shoulder maintenance program.	PAUL	The comments were passed to Works Operations and shouldering of Pine Road was completed in 2023.
Feral Cat - population out of hand	A grant for cat enclosure is currently in process.	SAM	Council, since we last met with the community, has committed to participating in a National Desexing Program. This Program is co-funded by the Cradle Coast Authority. The Program is focussed on domestic cats where eligible residents will be able to have their cat desexed and microchipped for free. Those on low incomes will be prioritised for subsidisation (those holding a valid pension, or concession card for example). This Program is expected to launch for Central Coast Council residents in March 2024 and will be advertised when available. Council does not currently undertake feral cat management activities; however, it understands that it has some very proactive community members within the Riana district
