DIRECTION 1 – THE SHAPE OF THE PLACE

- . Shared pathway to connect Forth to Ulverstone
- . RV Friendly bins in Forth – Pick up rubbish daily
- . Coin operated BBQ's and power outlet
- . RV to be closer to the back of Recreation Ground
- . Improve public facilities – baby change and disability
- . Bike connections to Cradle Mountain
- . Affordable housing disbursed through the area not in clusters
- . Forth Community Reps Group – 50/50 gender
- . Look at Forth Railway Bridge – ongoing maintenance and painting etc
- . Engender sense of community – personal safety – lighting, drugs and education

DIRECTION 2 – A CONNECTED CENTRAL COAST

- . Safe pathway fire station to bridges
- . Banner between pedestrians and road
- . Engage with community to achieve meaningful connections for new mothers
- . Engage with community to achieve meaningful connections with the LGBTI
- . Explore purchase of land for public open space (opposite shop)
- . Connect Forth to Shared Pathway
- . Improve Road safety – Don Road
- . Encourage no-smoking at community events – where the Council is supporting the event.

DIRECTION 3 – COMMUNITY CAPACITY AND CREATIVITY

- . Options for youth specific spaces in Forth – consult with local schools
- . Encourage digital literacy – liaise with local schools and volunteers
- . Expanded youth sports facilities – basketball ring and netball court
- . Youth representation on the Forth Community Consultative Committee
- . Lobby State Govt for more instrumental music teachers
- . Closer liaison between Council and local schools on Ulverstone Cultural Precinct – ARTS, SCIENCE, MUSIC TEACHERS

DIRECTION 4 –THE ENVIRONMENT AND SUSTAINABLE INFRASTRUCTURE

- . Waste – a community to be rewarded for reducing waste?
- . War on waste initiative
- . Schools – write into plans
- . Flooding in Forth
- . Water supply at Leith and Forth – TasWater – can go off without notice
- . Street trees (Ulverstone) preserve claret ash in main street
- . Plant native species for wildlife
- . Forth Road – Forth to Hilltop – what are the plans to upgrade – agricultural and heavy traffic?
- . Better amenities at Recreation Ground – or redevelop what is there.
