PENGUIN – 27 MARCH 2019

DIRECTION 1 – THE SHAPE OF THE PLACE

- . Concrete plinth around paddle pool (area opposite railway station revamp)
- . Beach access from Midway Point end – to Preservation Bay beach
- . Indoor chopping arena – Men’s Shed/Chopping arena area
- . Pull people to the Railway Station end of Main Road
- . Better road access to Mt Gnomon/promotion signage – 20–30mins walk to the top
- . Value of pond at Hiscutt Park – keep and value
- . Running out of residential land in and around Penguin – Growth = more commercial space required
- . Shared pathway – Penguin to Ulverstone
- . Issue with people polluting our valuable foreshore
- . Ocean Pool off low tide boat ramp
- . Lighting along shared pathways
- . Explore ‘Sulphur’ smell – intersection Penguin creek/ocean
- . Promotion of free camping and facilities
- . Ashwater Crescent – one-way street – slow down traffic

DIRECTION 2 – A CONNECTED CENTRAL COAST

- . Access to Penguin via Preservation Drive – 2nd left not 1st left
- . Smarter public transport – more smaller busses and increase frequency
- . Train Burnie to Devonport
- . Coastal pathway cycleway – locals and visitors – to winding good for bikes
