TURNERS BEACH – 20 MARCH 2019

DIRECTION 1 – THE SHAPE OF THE PLACE

- . Festival at the Wharf allowing locals to exhibit produce/product
- . Investigate feasibility of Ulverstone skate park facility for redevelopment
- . Redevelop nominates park to feature X-large adventure playground
- . Revamp and schedule regular events for the Ulverstone sound shell
- . Update town entry signs throughout the municipality with same theme/style
- . Redevelop modern pathways branch of share pathway if possible, linking to other open space areas. Interpretive maps at key intersections and areas.
- . Install pop up irrigation at key parks and recreation ground (trialed at Wharf and is green all year round)
- . Foreshore redevelopment at Bicentennial Park existing board walk onto pond and develop new timber walkways linking to beach hit and other areas.

- . Visual – to visitors – impact i.e. service station what impression people take
- . Look at parking – one way – i.e. Esplanade – don't want to destroy the seaside atmosphere – reduce speed, calming traffics
- . Susan Street – reduce speed, street calming (maybe trees) toilet amenities around playgrounds
- . Dire hazards – fuel load check
- . Beach accesses defined
- . Only one exit out of Turners Beach
- . Dogs off lead – irresponsible – dog park?
- . Bike Park – road rules for little kids (maybe behind tennis nets)
- . Signage – Turners Beach/Forth Road intersection

COMMUNITY MEETINGS – FEEDBACK IDEAS

- . Climate change – impacts on Turners Beach
- . Visual amenity – rubbish bins not empty
- . Energy efficient lights along bike paths
- . Revamp area near LaMar – looking at safety BBQ shelter west of this area.

DIRECTION 2 – A CONNECTED CENTRAL COAST

- . New coloured street signs
- . Widen main arterial roads
- . Line of site on town roundabouts (vegetation)
- . Connect road from Loonganna to Loyetea
- . Increase road maintenance budgets (fix what we have)
- . Update Policy on free camping in CCC

DIRECTION 3 – COMMUNITY CAPACITY AND CREATIVITY

- . Upgrade skate park
- . More free car parking around e.g. Buttons Creek
- . More social events at Depot
- . More rubbish bins around CBD and Forth area
- . Volunteers to pick up rubbish around CBD area
- . Bring back the siren at the Depot
- . HR to provide more activities

- . Bike Park for Turners Beach

- . 7-Day makeover for Turners Beach – (mentioned twice)
- . Community Garden V's Community storage for the beach
 - o Informal surf type shed 'club' style – so folks can access or support as available
 - o Bush to beach festival to celebrate
 - o 'Riverside' boat sheds for water activities
 - o 'pump & Jump' bike education – it suits the bike path
- . Promotion of services – YOUTH – mental health and Work placement
- . Development of support network
 - o Calendar of events
- . Development of Community Hub (local activities)
- . Food initiatives – community garden sustainable
- . Lighting (solar) on shared pathway – Ulverstone to Turners Beach
- . Limited RV Parking (4hrs)
- . Updated Visitors Guide

DIRECTION 4 –THE ENVIRONMENT AND SUSTAINABLE INFRASTRUCTURE

- . Develop a plan to make Anzac Park bank a more attractive
- . Underground irrigation systems for sports grounds (improved appearance)
- . Ground renovation equipment (Scarifiers etc.)
- . Tobruk Park duck pond improvements
- . Odor improvement Helen Street Pump Stations
- . Skip bins at Forth Rec Ground

COMMUNITY MEETINGS – FEEDBACK IDEAS

- . Garbage bins at Midway Point
- . Encourage use of Soundshell entertainment etc.
- . Upgrade BBQ' facilities at Shropshire Park to electronic
- . Raise rates in Maud Street
- . Remove dying dead trees
- . New Works Depot at River Park
- . 1–2 free tickets per rate payer to RRC

- . Footpaths – Turners Ave, Esplanade, Susan Street
- . Traffic management systems to slow traffics – make livable and keep pedestrians safe (Local Area Plan?)
- . Playground near La Mar – see other comments
- . Issues with people not caring about residents
- . Places for trucking parking area not affecting residents
- . Pedestrian crossing – La Mr or alternatively – speed humps or road marking
- . Crosby Street kerb and channeling – or alternatives – ore replacement – or widen road
- . Public toilets at servo – renovate or increase cleaning
- . Vinnies
- . Gales – neglected – Plan
- . Streetscaping – Trees planting areas (street trees) in conjunction with LATM's
- . Weed removal – Dunes – Sustaining area
- . Natural playground across from La Mar
