

Important information for the Driver

Registering to Drive the Community Bus

All Drivers must complete the Driver Declaration Form, this application to drive must be confirmed by the Council prior to driving the bus.

Vehicle Safety

The Driver must complete a pre-departure visual check and sign details in the log book.

The driver is required to do a visual check of the vehicle to ensure it is in a safe working order prior to departure. The driver is responsible for ensuring the bus is safe and road worthy. <u>Visual checklist attached</u>

In the event of a fault, please notify the Council as soon as practical and record details and submit the form to the Council. <u>Attached Fault form</u>

Incident Reporting

In the event of an accident, please contact 000 if an ambulance/fire/Police are required to attend and provide assistance. The driver must record details on the incident form - please include any other parties contact details - insurance contact, driver's license and registration details. <u>Attached incident form</u>

Passenger Behaviour

The Driver is responsible for ensuring that all passengers are behaving responsible to ensure safety whilst using the Community Bus.

Driver Behaviour

The Driver must at all times used the vehicle in a suitable manner, strictly adhering to all road rules and in accordance with the Traffic Act. Drivers found to breach any of these regulations will be refused access to utilise the Community Bus.
