- 1 Cemetery:
 - Central Coast Memorial Park (CCMP)
 - Ulverstone General Cemetery (UGC)
 - Penguin General Cemetery (PGC)
- 2 Full name of deceased
- 3 Date of death
- 4 Last residence of deceased
- 5 Date of birth of deceased
- 6 Age of the deceased at date of death
- 7 Was the deceased a Veteran?.....
- 8 Day and Date of Funeral
- 9 Time of Funeral (approximate time of arrival at cemetery)
- 10 Depth of Grave (single, double or triple)
- 11 Is this internment the first, second or third in the grave
- 12 Details of existing reservation, if applicable:
 - a) Name of Grave to be reopened
 - b) Relationship of the deceased to person previously buried
 - c) Date of internment of person previously buried
 - d) Grave No. of reservation
- 13 Full Name of Applicant (Next of Kin)
- 14 Address of Applicant
- 15 Funeral Company Name (if applicable)
- 16 Name of Representative or Undertaker
- 17 Signature of Representative or Undertaker

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All questions must be answered in full for burial arrangements to be made.

An order will be issued to the caretaker for a grave to be dug once this form is lodged either in person to the Administration Centre, 19 King Edward Street, Ulverstone or via email to admin@centralcoast.tas.gov.au
